



AMENDMENT REPORT FOR MAY 6-7, 2025

The following table provides an initial summary of amendments filed in the Illinois House and Senate on May 6–7, 2025, **which may have implications for county governments**. These amendments touch on public safety, taxation, infrastructure governance, pension training requirements, and housing policies. ISACo will take positions on these amendments if necessary and update our tracked bill service to reflect adopted amendments.

Bill (Amendment)	Summary	Potential County Impact
HB 2987 (HFA 0004)	Requires tornado safety plans coordinated with local emergency services and certified building inspectors.	Counties must receive plans and ensure inspectors hold ICC certification.
SB 0639 (SFA 0001)	Expands eminent domain powers to include sewer systems.	May impact counties involved in regional infrastructure planning.
SB 2264 (SFA 0001)	Mandates transparency for crime-free housing ordinances and annual assessments.	Directly affects counties with such ordinances and emergency service coordination.
SB 1456 (SFA 0002)	Requires annual pension board training and public tracking by State Treasurer.	County-affiliated pension board members must comply and documentation must be maintained.
SB 2253 (SFA 0003)	Allows expedited procedures for IDOT eminent domain cases and alternative service methods.	Supports faster land acquisition processes in counties for state transportation projects.
SB 2044 (HFA 0001)	Permits use of secure digital signatures for official documents.	Counties may modernize signature collection processes for public forms.
