



AMENDMENT REPORT FOR MAY 14, 2025

The following table provides an initial summary of amendments filed in the Illinois House and Senate on May 14, 2025, **which may have implications for county governments**. These amendments touch on public safety, taxation, infrastructure governance, pension training requirements, and housing policies. ISACo will take positions on these amendments if necessary and update our tracked bill service to reflect adopted amendments.

Bill (Amendment)	Summary	Potential County Impact
HB 1362 (SFA 1)	This amendment extends the period during which public employees may receive differential compensation while on voluntary active military service from 365 days to three consecutive years.	Counties, as public employers, may need to revise personnel policies and budget for extended salary compensation for eligible employees.
HB 1364 (SFA 3)	Reduces the number of appointments the Will County Executive may make to the Joliet Arsenal Development Authority from 6 to 1. The appointment authority is redistributed among 10 municipalities within Will County.	Significantly diminishes Will County's appointment authority and influence on the Board, affecting county-level input into regional development activities.
SB 1827 (SFA 1)	Authorizes counties and municipalities to engage a licensed design professional to assist in administering design-build contracts.	Offers counties additional flexibility and professional oversight in managing complex infrastructure or capital improvement projects.
